C-U Change is a youth development program through the Don Moyer Boys & Girls Club that will provide programming, mentoring and action planning to at-risk youth ages 13-18 (grades 9 to 12) in Champaign County. C-U Change will deliver a strength-based, innovative approach to engage and support youth at risk in school and in the community.

The C-U Change program will serve at-risk youth ages 13-18 (grades 9 to 12). This program is designed for youth who have been impacted by the juvenile justice system and/or with social, emotional, or behavioral challenges.

C-U Change will work to provide daily support for youth to navigate the school environment, deal with peer pressures, develop problem-solving skills, engage with local community, and graduate from high school with a plan for the future.

Program Goals:

- To expose youth enrolled in the C-U Program to positive youth development programming.
- To establish intensive and highly structured evidence- based programming.
- To establish a plan of action for targeted youth of the C-U Change Program through Case Management.
- To create opportunities for positive interaction, feedback and involvement for guardians/ parents of youth enrolled in the C-U Change Program.
- To improve school involvement of youth enrolled in the C-U Change program.

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
